

## Directions to Training For Advancement by car

### From the North or South

We recommend that if you are travelling from the north or south, you leave the M6 Motorway at Junction 15 and follow the A519 towards Newcastle-under-Lyme, then the A525 Whitchurch road to Keele.

### From the East

From the M1, follow the A50 to Stoke-on-Trent and Newcastle-under-Lyme, then the A525 to Keele.

### From the West

Approach by the A525 road.

The Keele University complex lies two miles west of Newcastle-under-Lyme on the A525 road to Whitchurch, Nantwich and Crewe. The main entrance is clearly signposted; at the first roundabout go right (All traffic) continue straight over second roundabout. Innovation Centre 2 (IC2) is the third building on the left and Training For Advancement is located on the 1<sup>st</sup> Floor.

**Please be aware that the University operates a strict car parking/clamping policy. Please park in the visitors' spaces at the front of the building where possible - if all these spaces are taken, you may park in the spaces marked Training for Advancement which are situated on the middle row of the car park.**

Upon entering the building please sign the visitors' book, then use the buzzer (we are number 11) to speak to a member of Training For Advancement staff who will release the door to give you access to the lift/stairs and the first floor. Training For Advancement is to the right when you alight from the lift or staircase.

## Arrival by other forms of transport

### By Air

The nearest Airports to Keele are Manchester and Birmingham. Manchester is approximately 40 miles away and Birmingham is 50 miles away.

### By Rail

The nearest stations are Stoke-on-Trent (5 miles) and Crewe (11 miles).

There is a taxi rank on the grounds of Stoke-on-Trent Station, please follow the signs within the station to locate this. There is a taxi rank outside Crewe Station. Typically the journey takes 15-20 minutes from Stoke-on-Trent Station and 20-25 minutes from Crewe.

### By Bus

From Stoke-on-Trent Station – PMT buses leave the stop which is on the other side of the road, to the left of the station entrance, every 30 minutes. The journey to the University complex takes about 35 minutes. From Crewe Station – Arriva buses to Hanley leave the stop outside the train station entrance. They travel through Keele campus. The journey takes about 40 minutes.
